RAPCA Releases Annual Report For Calendar Year 2016

2016 was a busy and productive year for the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA.). The annual report summarizes all of the air quality measurements for Clark, Greene Miami and Montgomery, Counties and summarizes all of the permitting and inspection activities for all six counties that RAPCA serves. Sixth-Generation Ohio MSGP for Stormwater Issued Final

Ohio EPA's new Multi-Sector General Permit (MSGP) for Industrial Stormwater Discharges (OHR000006) was issued final in May, and the effective date of the permit was June 1, 2017. Facilities currently covered by HR00005 must re-apply for coverage by September 22. SWPPPs for currently covered facilities must be updated within 180 days of the permit issue date.
